## Journals in the Abridged Index Medicus (AIM): Core Clinical Journals

THE *Abridged Index Medicus*, which the National Library of Medicine stopped printing in 1997, was designed for individual clinicians and the libraries of small hospitals and clinics. It contained bibliographic information on articles from more than a hundred English language journals. Although the printed version is a historical artifact, the AIM subset of journals is still being maintained as a means for limiting searches. In PubMed, this subset is also called “Core Clinical Journals.” It can be useful in producing a quick—though incomplete—list of citations. While the AIM subset is not ideal, you may find it useful in setting up your own personal list of journals for searching.
